Katya Cengel became patient number 090 71 51 at the Roth Psychosomatic Unit at Children's Hospital in 1986. She was 10 years old. Hospital staff put her in a straitjacket – and on anti-psychotic medication. Thirty years later Katya, now a journalist, tracks down the doctors, psychologists and counselors who once cared for her. The experience inspired her book, Straitjackets and Lunch Money, and her role as a Big Sister.






About Elizabeth Barrett
